Beachplum Quilters of the Jersey Shore "Everything's coming up Roses", Quilt Show Rules 2018

- 1. Beachplum Quilting Guild members only are permitted to submit quilted items and must have worked on the item entered.
- 2. Limit of 5 entries per guild member, until a maximum of 80-85 received, and then no more accepted.
- 3. Deadline for registration form is March 1, 2018. A registration fee of \$4.00 (nonrefundable, check only) and color photo must accompany each registration form, per entry (there is no fee for registration of challenge quilt entries). The show committee understands that an entry may not have its quilting or binding completed when the entry photo is taken. Please print your name, address, and phone # on the back of photo or digital print. All photos or prints become the property of Beachplum Quilting guild and will not be returned. No late registration entries. No exceptions.
- 4. Entries must be finished and in "show condition" i.e. clean, free of debris, smoke and odor free. The decision of the Quilt Show Committee to exclude a quilt with regards to this rule is final.
- 5. All quilts must have 3 layers and be quilted by hand or machine, or tied unless this requirement is inconsistent with the intent of the pattern i.e. cathedral window, yo-yo, crazy quilt, etc.
- 6. Wearable art entries must use one or more of the techniques used in quilting i.e. piecing, appliqué, quilting, etc.
- 7. Entries must be completed no earlier than April 9, 2016. Date of our last guilt show.
- 8. All persons involved in making the entry must be listed on the entry form, and credit must be given to the author, teacher, artist, etc. who inspired the work. (If not an original design, credit must be given to the source.)
- 9. Please be sure to give credit to professional quilters in story card description.
- 10. Every entry must have a fabric ID label sewn on the quilt back (or inside wearable art), no pins accepted. For fairness in judging, you are required to baste a piece of fabric over the name(s) of the quilt maker(s) on label before sending the entry. A quilt sleeve must be sewn on the top back no more then 90 inches from the bottom end of the quilt. (Usually 4.5 "x width of the quilt)
- 11. If an exhibited quilt is intended for sale, it should be registered with the Country Store, and if sold, commission of 10% of sale price will be retained.
- 12. It is the responsibility of the buyer to make arrangements with the seller via the country store to transfer possession of the sold guilt after the show is complete.
- 13. All entries must remain on display for the duration of the show.
- 14. Quilt show registration committee and judge reserves the right to move entries to correct categories.
- 15. Submitted items should be received in a fabric bag or pillowcase. Please fold quilt so that ID label is clearly visible. Use a separate cloth bag for each item and label bag with ID info. Entrant's name and phone #. NO PLASTIC BAGS.
- 16. Entries must be delivered to registration drop off times/locations: April 11, 2018 Elks Lodge 10 AM 12 PM.
- 17. QUILT ENTRIES NOT DELIVERED BY DROP OFF DEADLINE WILL BE CONSIDERED WITHDRAWN.

- 18. Entrants will be issued a claim check for each item when dropped off and received. Claim check must be presented when picking up item after show. The show ends at 4:00pm, Sunday, and then the building will be cleared. The break down committee will take down quilts. The registration committee will organize the quilts and announce when ready for pick up.
