



Introduction to Quilt Judging Two-day Seminar

Whether you are a quilter interested in perfecting skills and knowledge, a quilt professional such as a teacher or appraiser, or someone interested in becoming a quilt judge, this seminar provides a thorough foundation in all aspects of quilt judging.

In this Two-Day Seminar, you will learn through a combination of discussions, Power Point presentations, and hands-on mock judging with Sandra L Dorrbecker. Sandra is a Quilt Judging Seminar Instructor (QJSI), qualified by the National Association of Certified Quilt Judges (NACQJ), 2015-. Original certification as a certified judge with the National Quilting Association (NQA), 1994-2015. A career judging more than 177 events in 15 states.

This Seminar covers all aspects of quilt judging, including the job of judging, evaluating design and workmanship, categories and awards, judging systems, setting up the judging floor, and judging versus jurying. The discussion also includes certification requirements from the National Association of Certified Quilt Judges (NACQJ.com), the only national certifying organization for quilt judges.

Students receive handouts such as resource recommendations, art and design terms with definitions, a glossary, sample contracts, expense forms and many other unique handouts.

While the discussion includes certification requirements by the only national certifying organization for quilt judges National Assoc. of Certified Quilt Judges (NACQJ), this seminar *does not certify students nor is it a program prerequisite.*
