

## Pattern for 2 Eyeglass Holders

Finished Size: 3-3/4" x 7"

SUPPLIES: 1 fat quarter, cut into 2 pieces: 8-3/4" x 15-1/4", Set aside 1 piece( makes 2nd holder)

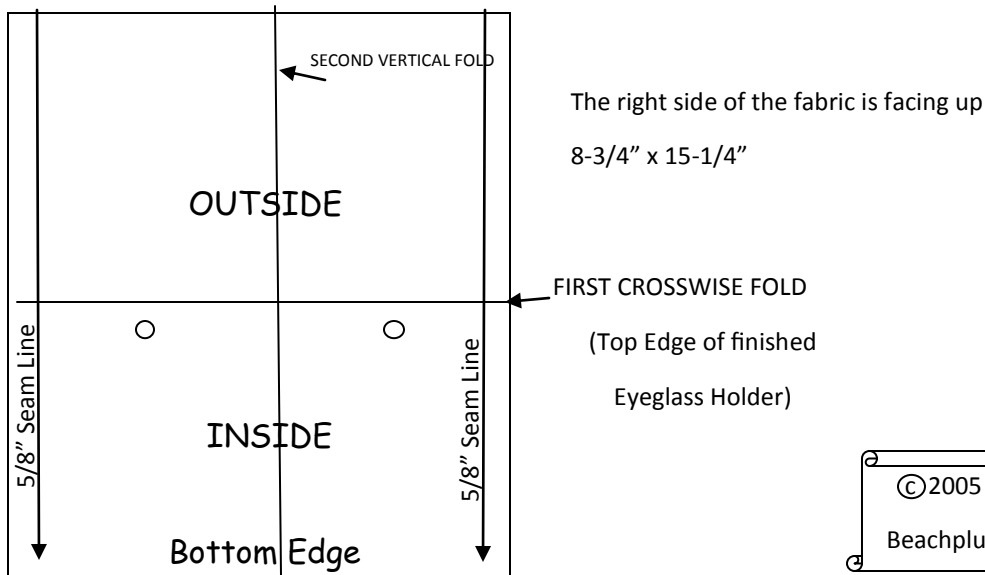
2 sets: round 5/8" self-stick, hook & loop fasteners, 1 set for each holder

1 piece of batting 8-3/4 x 15-1/2; cut it into 2 pieces: 8-3/4" x 7-5/8"-set aside 1 piece

Sewing thread, machine, iron

### DIRECTIONS:

- Fold 1 piece of fabric in half crosswise, wrong sides together, and press. Then fold lengthwise without opening the first fold, and press. Open the fabric like a "book" with the first fold at the top.
- Mark a line 1/4" down from the crosswise fold. Open the first fold & mark a 5/8" seam line down the left & right long raw edges on the wrong side of the fabric. Do not refold the first fold.
- Attach & sew hook & loop pieces, on the right side of the fabric, aligning them below the 1/4" line and crosswise first fold. Center them between the lengthwise fold and the 5/8" marked seam line.
- Align the batting piece (8-3/4" x 7-5/8") on the wrong side, matching raw edges on 3 sides.
- Gently fold in half, lengthwise, right sides together, and sew on the 5/8" seam line, catching the batting in the seam.
- Press open the side seam allowance and trim to about 1/4". Turn the fabric so it covers the batting and carefully align the inside seams. The right sides are now facing out and the hook & loop is outside. The bottom seam is open.
- Sew the bottom edge with approx. 5/8" seam. Trim carefully. Turn right side out. Press.
