

## FEBRUARY- Valentine Heart Square



### Materials:

Bedrock Cloud (BC) fabric

Scraps of pinks and reds in either solids, prints, or a combination of solids and prints.

### To Prepare:

~From Bedrock Cloud fabric, cut one square 4-1/2 " .

~From Bedrock Cloud fabric, cut two strips 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" and two strips 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" 1-1/2" x 12-1/2"

~Cut seventeen 2-1/2" squares from your scraps of reds and pinks.

~Cut two 3" squares of BC and two 3" squares of a pink/red.

Using the technique in the General Instructions / Accuracy sheets, prepare four half square triangles, using BC and pink/red.

~Trim the four half square triangles to measure 2-1/2" each

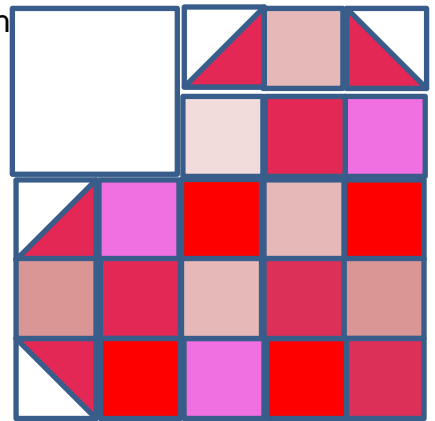
~Before you begin sewing the squares together, check to see that you have the following:

one 4 1/2" BC square

four 2-1/2" half square triangle blocks

seventeen 2-1/2" assorted scraps squares

~Lay them out as shown at right



### Construction:

~Piece the first row together and press to the left.

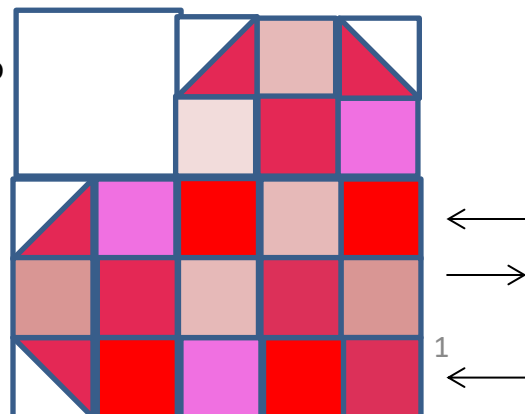
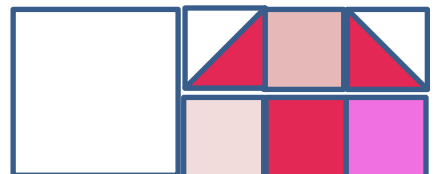
~Piece the second row together and press to the right

~Sew Rows 1 and 2 together (pressing in opposite directions should enable the seams to nest).

~ Sew the Row 1-2 unit to the 4-1/2" BC square.

~Piece last three rows of blocks together. Following the pressing pattern above, press Row 3 to the left, Row 4 to the right, and Row 5 to the left.

~ Stitch to completed first section.

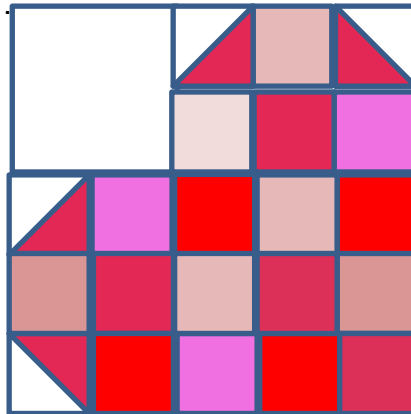

~Press horizontal seams to one side or open, as desired.

~ Block should measure 10-1/2" by 10-1/2"



~Add shorter Bedrock Cloud strips to two opposite sides for borders, and then two longer Bedrock Cloud strips to the other two opposite sides, making the block 12-1/2" by 12-1/2".
