

JANUARY- Log Cabin

Materials:

- Kona Tiger Lily orange fabric- in packet
- Holtz fabric (six strips)-in packet
- Scraps of browns and tans, both lights and darks (six in all)



To Prepare:

- ~Cut a 3-1/2" center square of Tiger Lily Orange fabric.
- ~Cut 2" wide strips from your chosen fabrics, including the Holtz. *If you prefer precutting your strips, these are the lengths you will need:*
 - From the Holtz fabric, 3.5", 5", 6.5", 8", 9.5", 11"*
 - From the browns and tans: 5", 6.5", 8", 9.5", 11", 12.5". You can use the same color, in pairs, or different shades, going from lightest to darkest.*

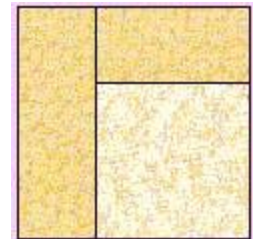
Construction:

- ~Build your cabin by adding 2" strips around the orange center, starting with your lighter fabrics and ending with your darker. Press seams (either open or to one side) after each strip is added. Work clockwise from the wrong side as you add strips! Diagrams show how it looks from the right side.

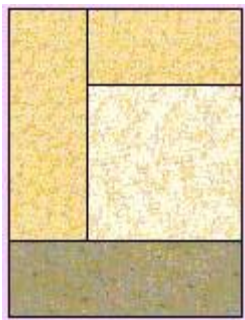
1. Center square (orange) with first Holtz strip



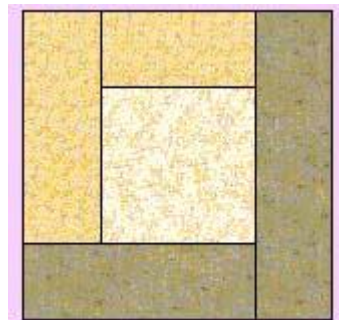
2. Second Holtz strip is added.



3. Lightest tan strip is added.

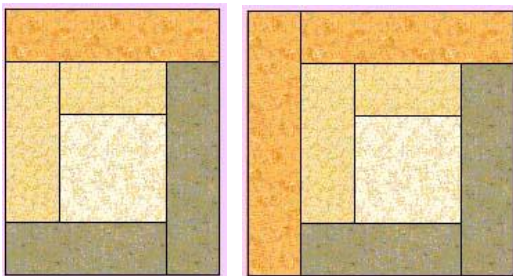


4. Another light tan strip is added.

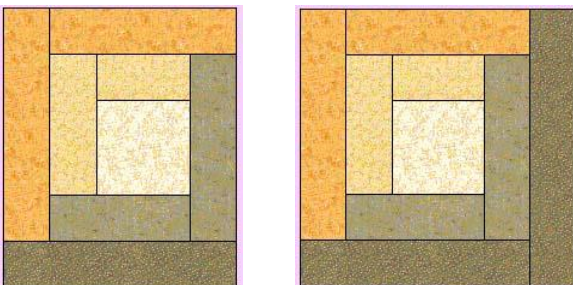


~Check your measurements after first round of strips is complete; block should measure 6-1/2".

5-6. Add two more Holtz strips.

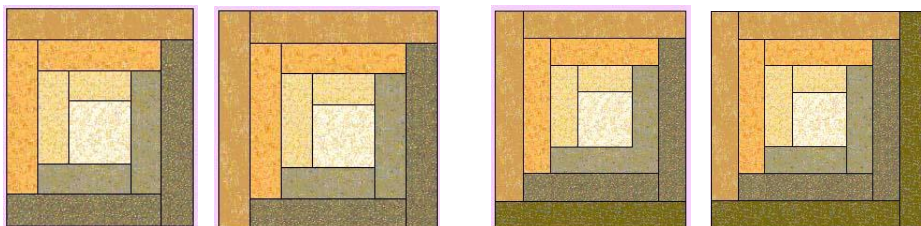


7-8. Then two more tan/brown strips.



After your second complete round of strips, the block should measure 9-1/2".

9-12. Then two more Holtz and two more tan/brown strips.



~The completed block should measure 12-1/2".
