

## How to Make a Quilt Sleeve

1. Cut a strip of fabric equal to the width of your quilt and 9" wide.
2. Fold the 9" ends under twice and stitch close to the edge. With the wrong sides together, sew the strip into a long tube.
3. Press the tube with the seam line on the bottom center.
4. Position the sleeve about one inch from the top of your quilt, on the back. The tube seam should be hidden, facing the back of the quilt.
5. Whipstitch the tube to the back of your quilt, being careful not to let the stitches show on the front.
6. Be sure to stitch down one layer on the ends of the sleeve to the back of the quilt so a hanging rod can be inserted and not touch the quilt itself.
