TIPSY CORNER

When assembling a quilt as a gift, make a small pocket on the label and insert a shiny penny dated the year of the gift. It feels like you are also giving the recipient good luck and prosperity.



Pieces of fabric from the quilt top can be added behind the label for future use should the quilt need repair.

her sewing room exploits by her cats, who just want to help with EVERYTHING, and a dog who very respectfully naps through every sewing session.

We will be hosting a lecture with Jan on Friday, October 18th and a Workshop on Saturday, October 19th. The lecture is called, "Finish the D@#N Quilt," and the workshop is Scrapstashtic Shenanigans and actually using your fabric stash. The cost for

the Workshop is only \$30 for Beachplum Members. You bring a sewing machine, fabric (whatever scraps you would like to use up), sewing supplies and lunch. The Workshop runs from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. and we will learn how to make 3 stash-busting projects that make good hostess gifts, kid presents or donations. 
Block of the Month Program 2024-2025
