We hope so!! If YOU have a tip that makes your quilting, pressing, piecing, pattern holding, fabric storage, applique, binding, etc., easier, PLEASE share it with us! We want to run the "Tipsy Corner" in every issue of the news letter, and the more the merrier! If a picture (or series of pictures) helps you explain your tip better, send them along too. We would love to gather enough tips to maybe even make a small booklet to sell!

# TIPSYCORNER

I roll my pressed binding up onto an empty toilet tissue roll. I pin the first end on and roll, trying to keep the bulk as evenly distributed as possible. I put a string about 20 inches long thru the tube and tie it off like a necklace. I wear this "binding necklace" as I sew my binding on to my quilt, it rolls out smoothly with no tangles, and it is easy to keep the binding perfectly even with the edge of my quilt.


