It is an “itty bitty” yo yo pumpkin, which is about 4 inches tall.

Here are the supplies you need to bring if you would like to make the pumpkin. This is a hand sewing project.



Equipment:

- Hand sewing needle
- Orange and green polyester thread
- Fabric scissors
- Pencil or fabric marker

Materials:

You will need orange fabric to cut the number and size of circles as listed in the table below. Please note, one of the circles is cut in green fabric.

Circle Size	Number to Cut
4 inch	Cut 1 green
5 inch	Cut 2 orange
5 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch	Cut 2 orange
6 inch	Cut 2 orange
4 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch	Cut 1 orange

Note: the orange fabric can be all the same or mix it up with different fabrics. The rest of the items needed will be supplied at the meeting.

We would like to continue our Charity Quilt projects as well. There is a quilt in progress. If you would like to work on this quilt, please bring your sewing machine and your usual sewing tools.

Come spend a nice fall afternoon with us. Remember to bring a Show and Tell item to share.
