Donna had asked for all our NEW members since our April Quilt Show to stand and introduce themselves and the first person to stand was our newest Member who joined that evening. We have 13 new members since the show!

Members not wearing a Name Badge were asked to stand and introduce themselves as the "fine" for not having a name badge.

**QUILT SHOW:** I, Gloria, was asked to give a report of our 2024 Quilt Show. I did and was pleasantly surprised by an appreciative group of members, and was not expecting the applause which as you could tell my by expression. Thank you so much you made me feel great.

Imagine, for our two (2) day, Quilt Show, all the months of work, preparation, and meetings can be exhausting but you all came across willing to put in sacrifice, time and energy necessary. <u>You all ROCKED the</u> <u>Show, Big Time!!!</u>

We have been contacted by Friends of Island Beach State Park to see if we want to participate in their Festival again this year. Donna D. asked Marlene S. to reply yes, so be thinking about what can be made and sold. The patriotic banners and table runners were very successful, microwave bowl cozies also sold well. People came back, from previous Festivals, looking the card holders that were old cd's covered and glued together. Donna D. has a cute and easy pattern for Dog or Cat collar bandanas.

Donna D. requested a report from the nomination committee and the following slate was presented for nomination: President: Dina N. Vice President: Dona S. Secretary: Kit D. and Treasurer: Erma H. Donna asked if there any other nominations for Elected Officers for the Beachplum Quilters Guild 2024-2026 Term? Hearing none, she asked for a motion that the Slate of Officers as presented by the Nomination Committee be accepted and declared the Elected officers of Beachplum Quilters of the Jersey Shore for the 2024-2026 term: Motion made by Chris L. and seconded by Jane S. Motion carried and approved. The Elected Slate of Officers will take office at the Start of New Business at our June meeting.

**PROGRAMS:** Dina began with a short Lecture on Foundation Paper Piecing. First Dina explained the difference between FPP & EPP (English Paper Piecing). FPP typically takes less time than EPP. Templates are typically larger and the sewing is done by machine for FPP and EPP is sewn by hand. FPP was originally a method used to stabilize pieces of fabric that were stitched together. It first became popular in the 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> Century in England, although a 15<sup>th</sup> Century Italian piece, the "Impruneta" cushion, owned by Antonio Agli, may have used foundation piecing.

Dina touched on types of paper one can use i.e.: printer paper, velum, Carol Doak's specialty paper and freezer paper just to name a few.

Dina will be the Instructor at the Workshop for Foundation Paper Piecing on Saturday, May 18, 2024 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and will cover the basics on FPP during her workshop. Don't forget to bring your lunch.

CHARITY QUILTS: Carol C. stated "just keep the guilts coming". No sooner did she make this statement that many of the Quilts from Show & Tell were donated.

BLOCK OF THE MONTH: Due to the Quilt Show in April both the April - April Showers blocks, and May -Snapdragon blocks were both displayed. Sherri McC. won the April Shower blocks and Ivette R. won the Snapdragon blocks. Congratulation Ladies!

**DOOR PRIZES:** The lucky winners are Diane W., Terri P., and Patti B.

SHOW & TELL: There were many guilts during Show & Tell that were donated for Charity Quilts. There was an abundance of guilts being shown and as usual our Guild members continue to amaze us with their talents in guilting. 
